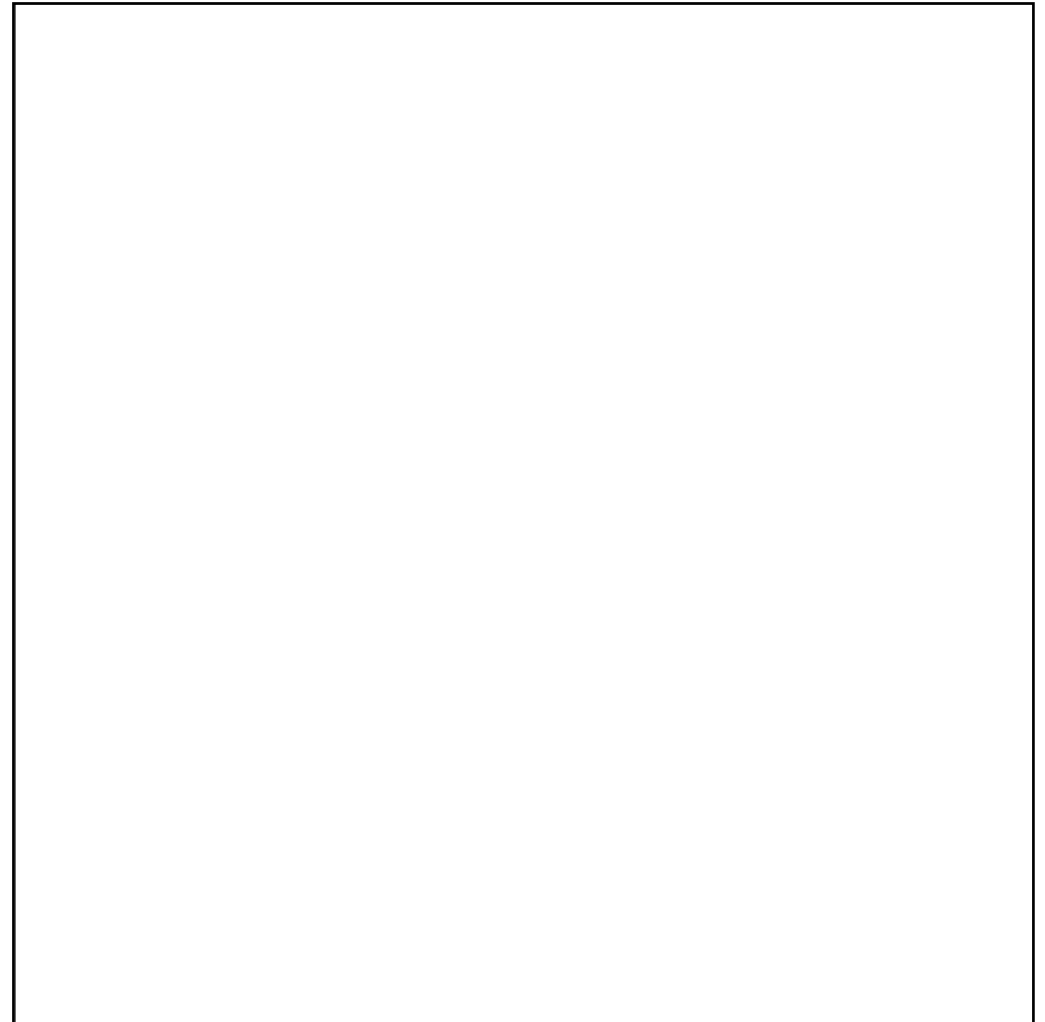

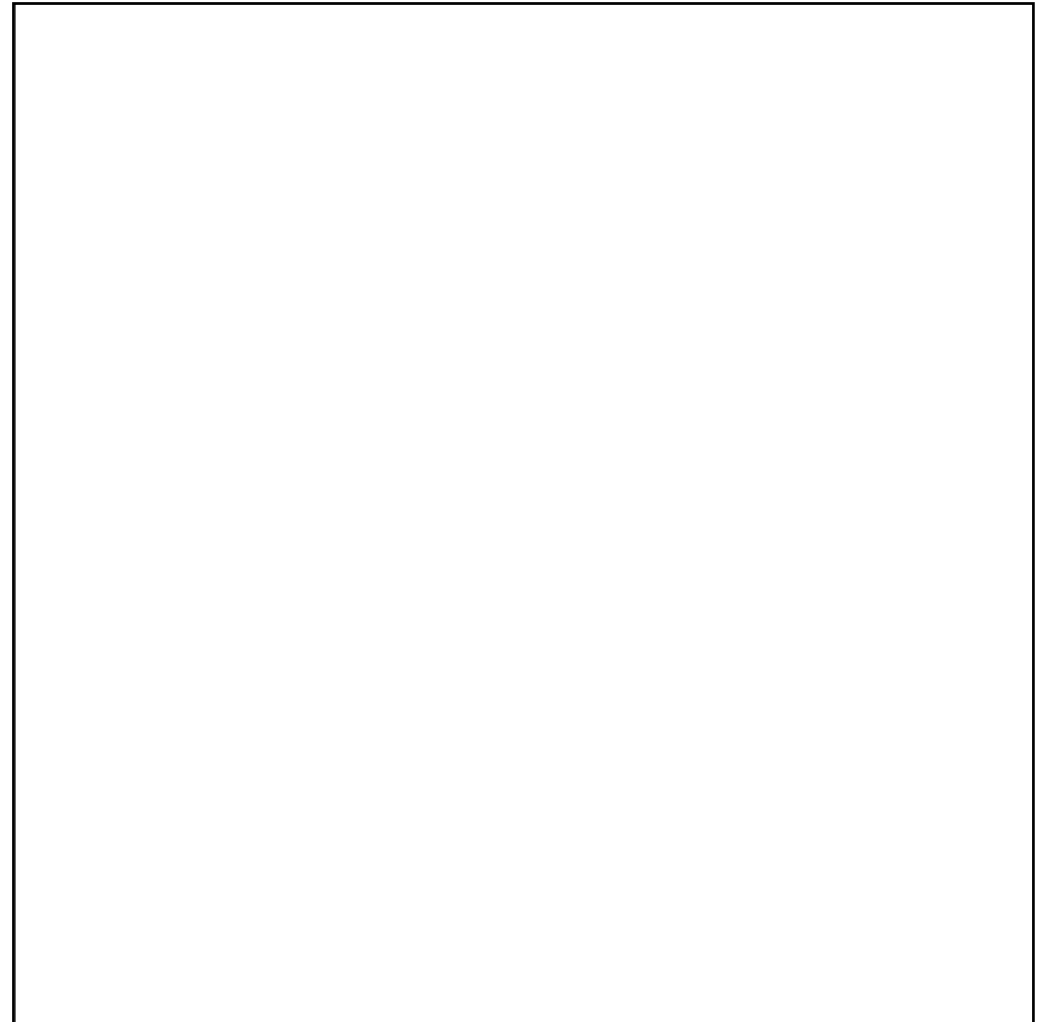

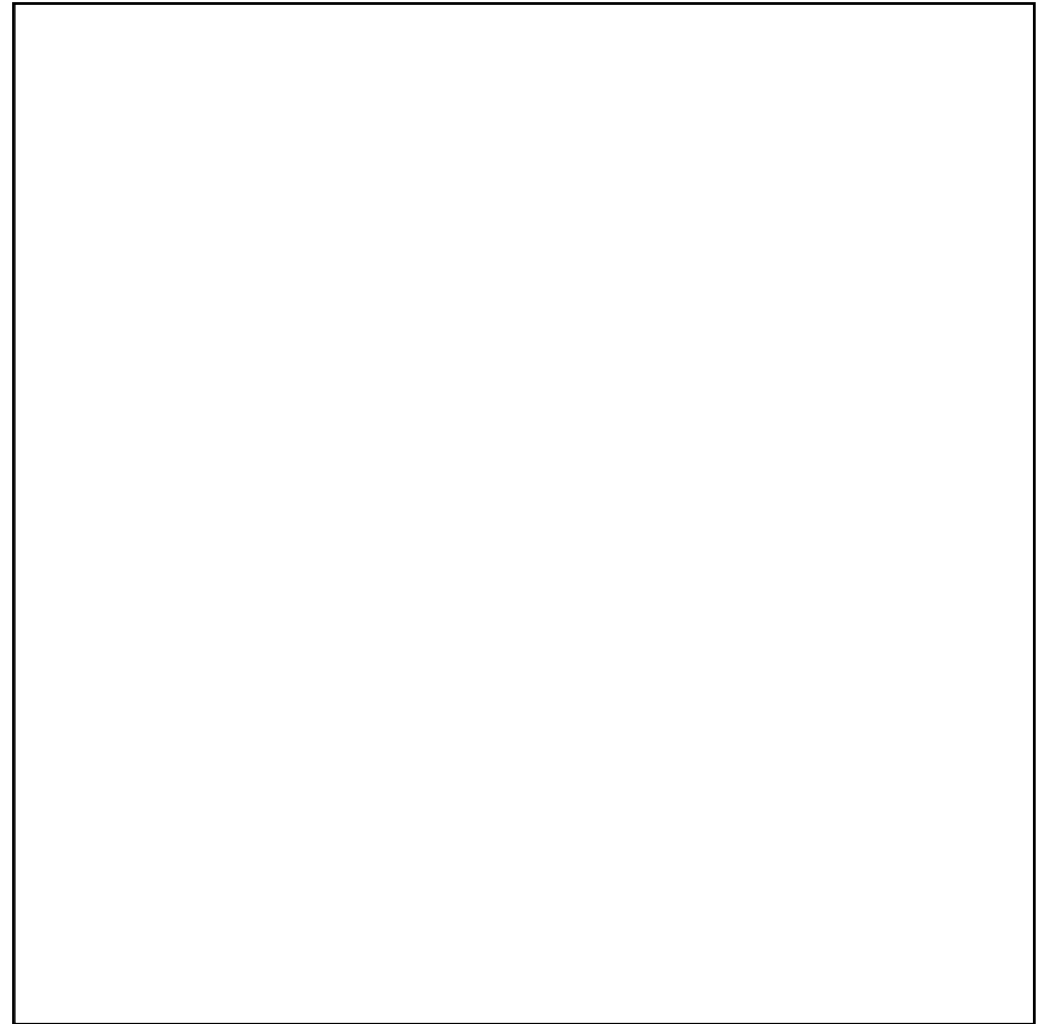
– **weight**



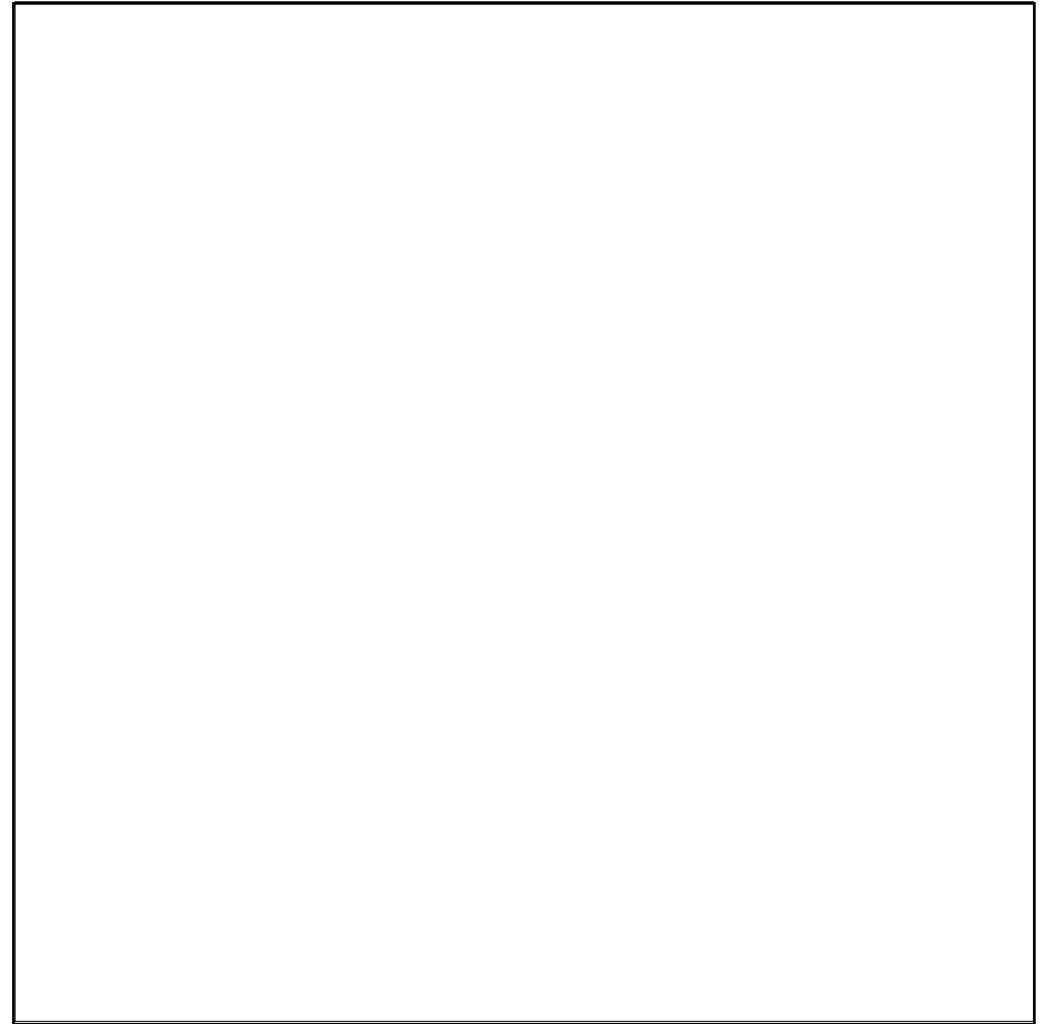
– **weight + width**



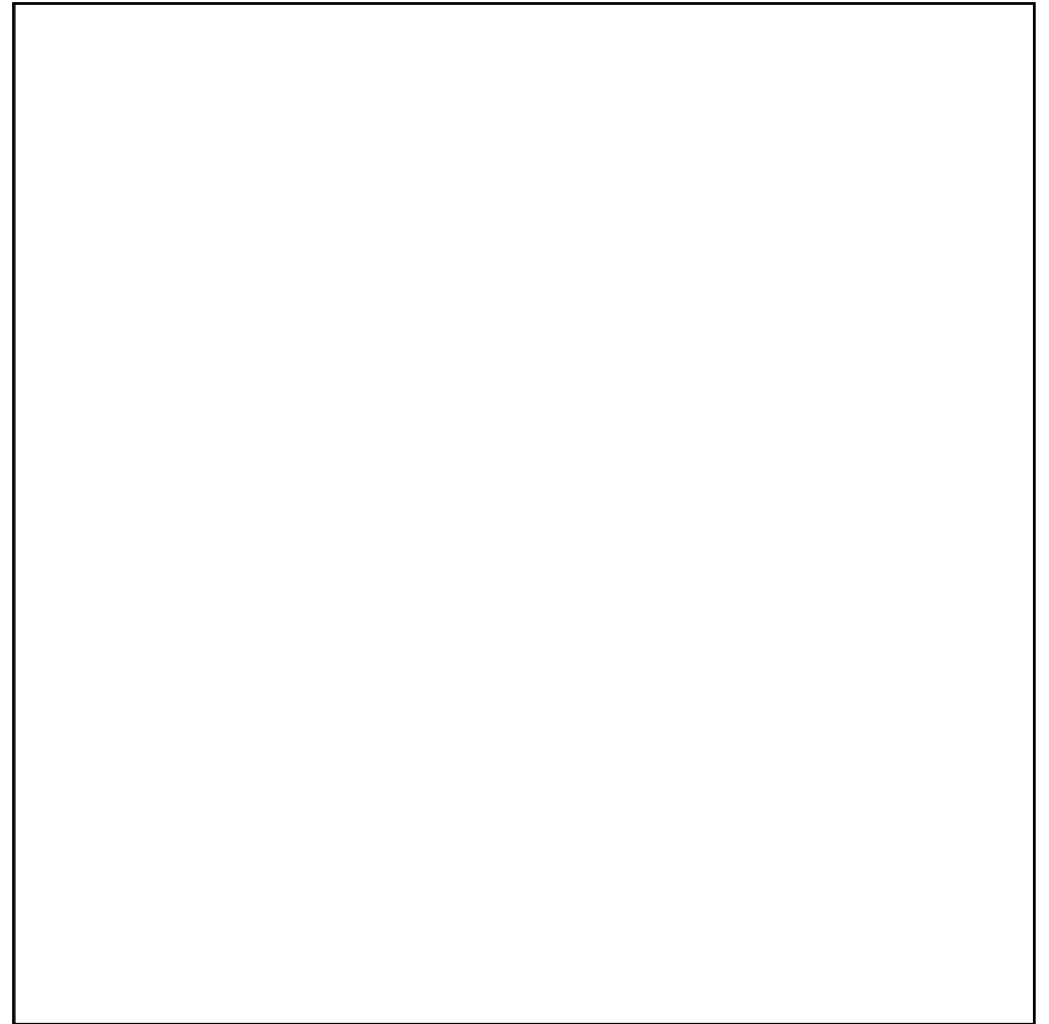
– **point size**



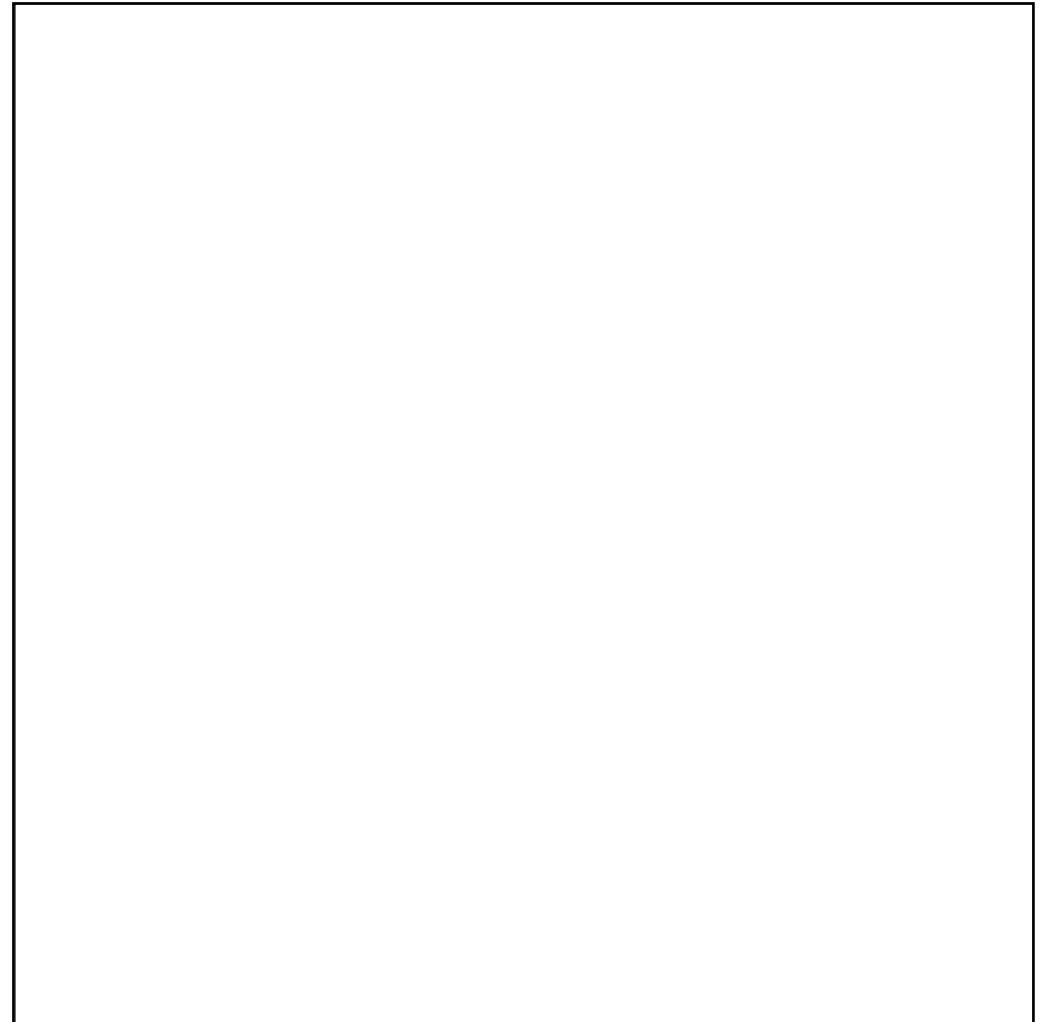
# – tracking



## – successive motion

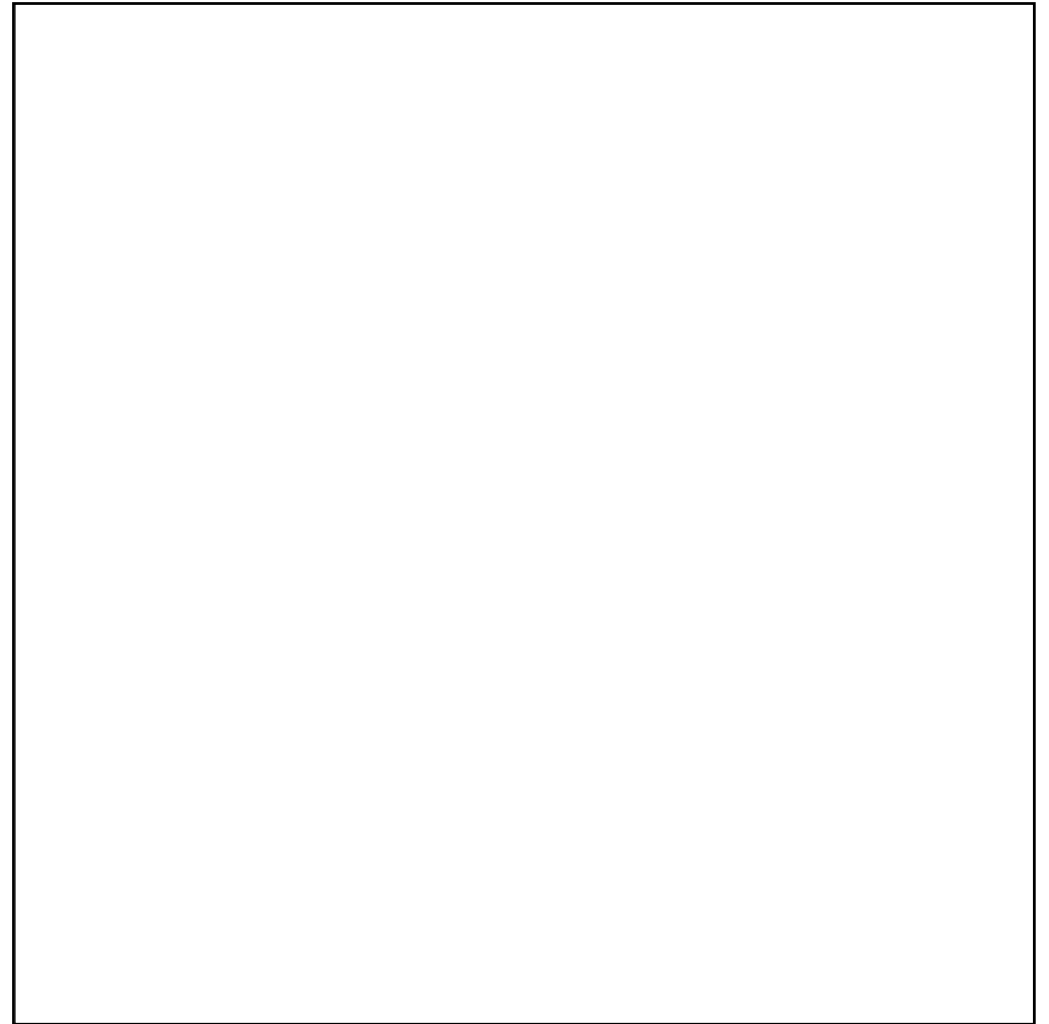

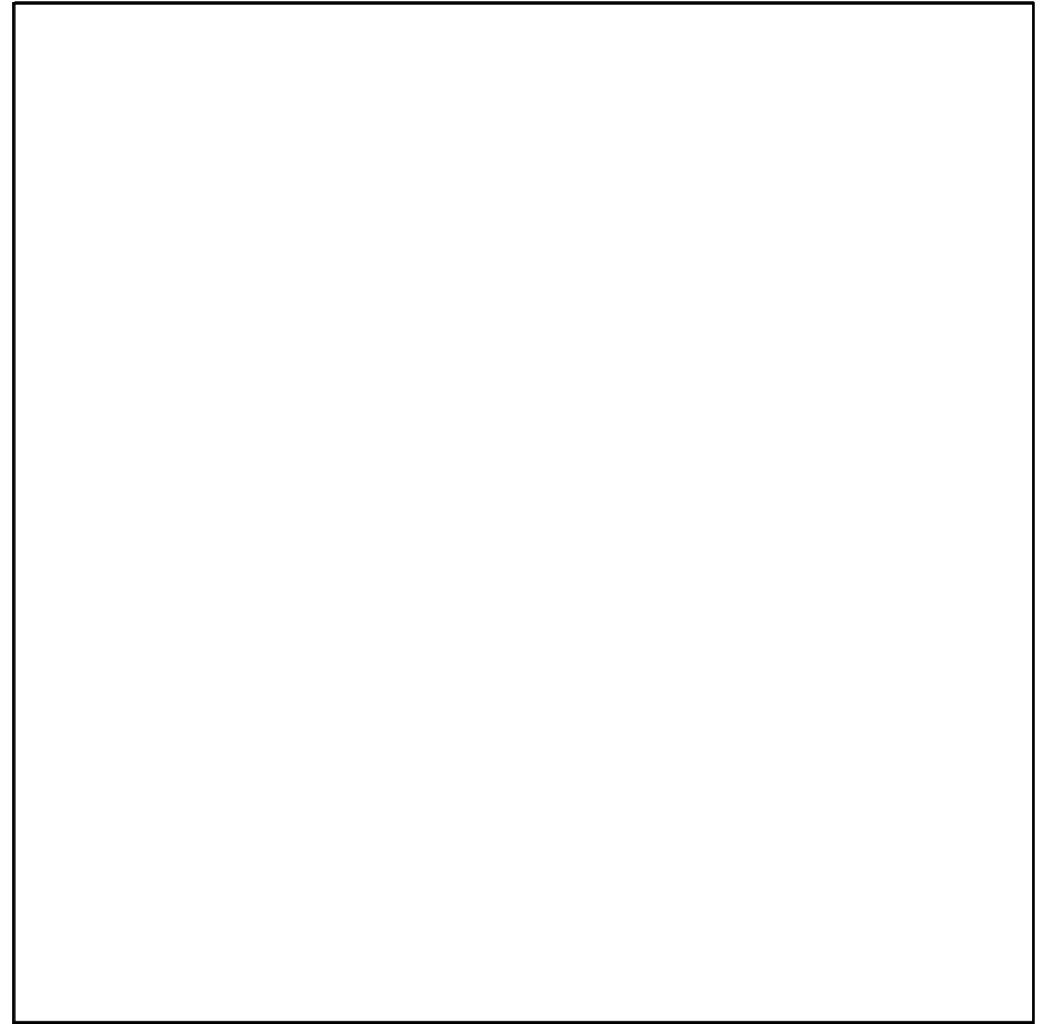

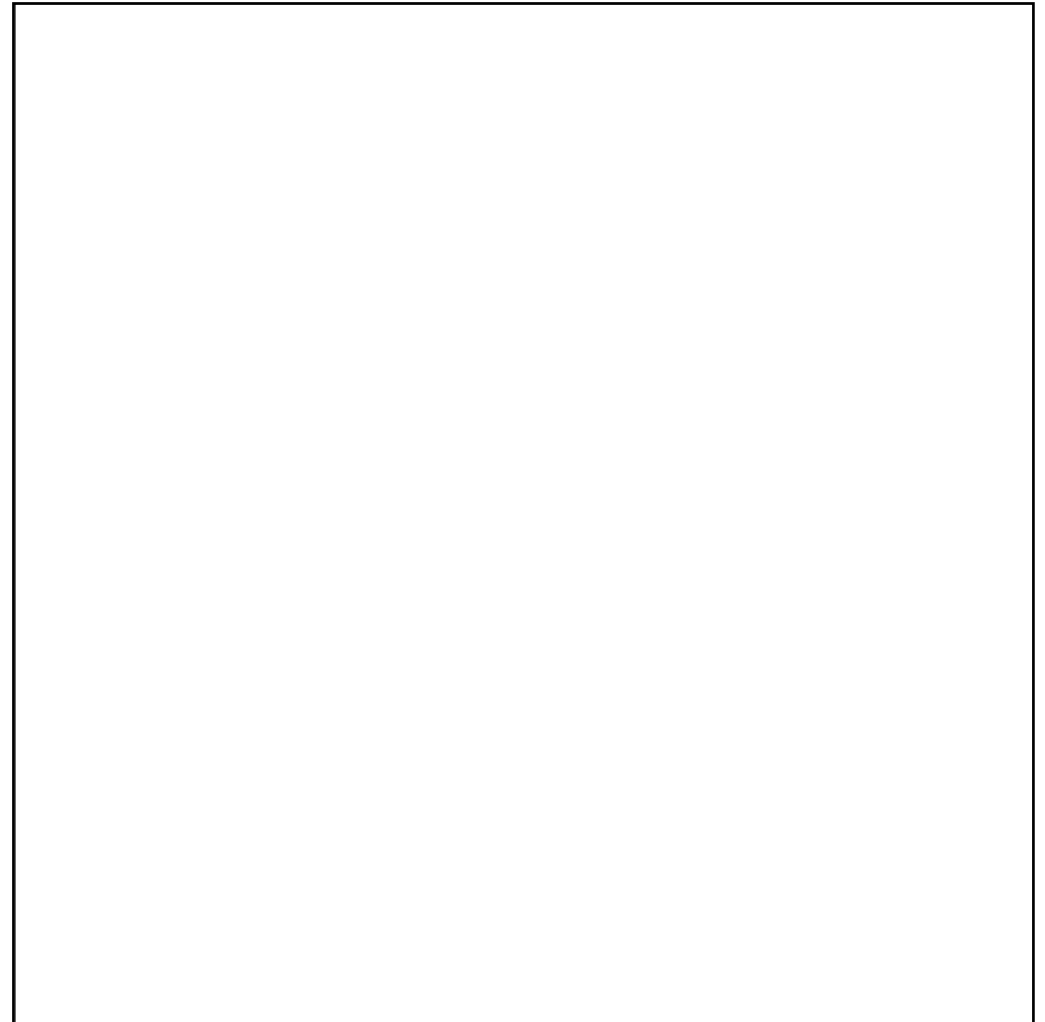


– **motion from right to left**



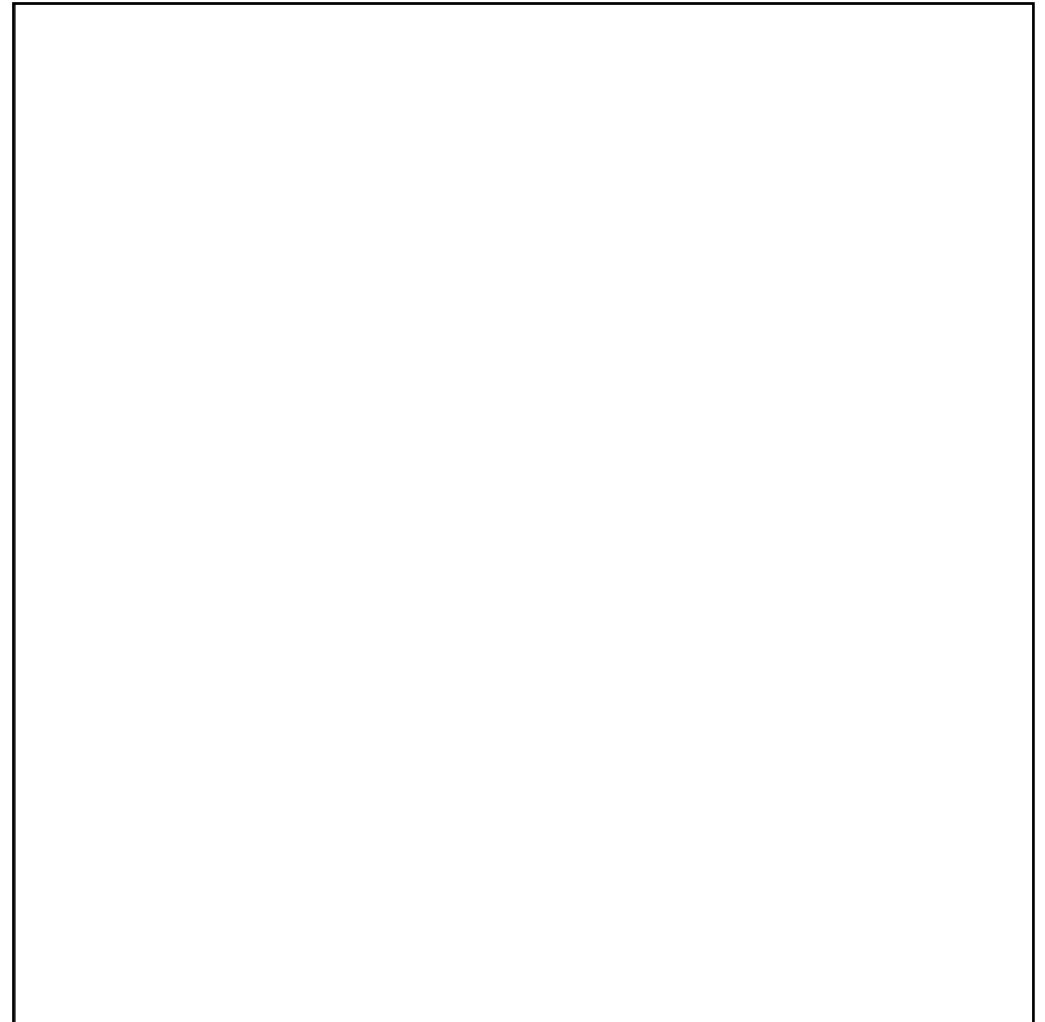
## – motion from left to right

\_ Disadvantage: decreased readability

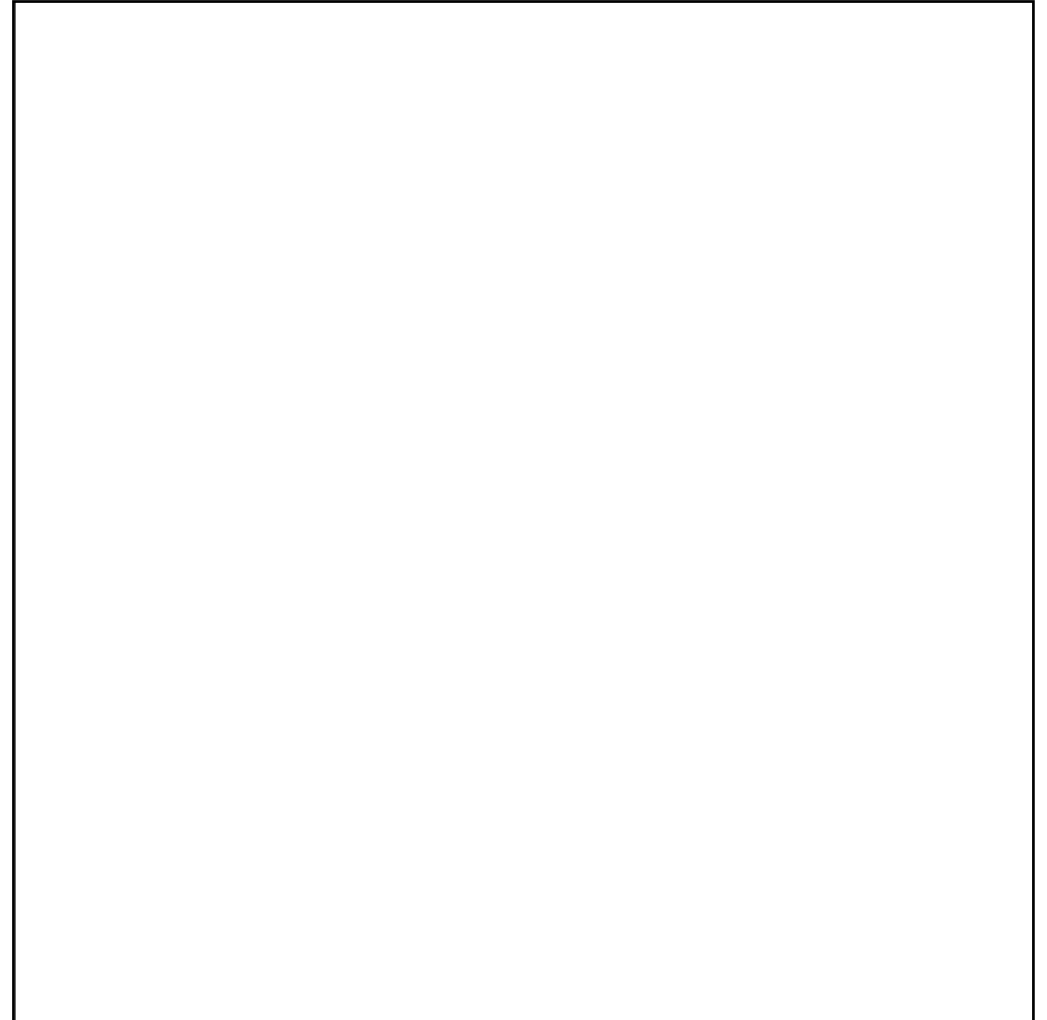


## \_ change of focus

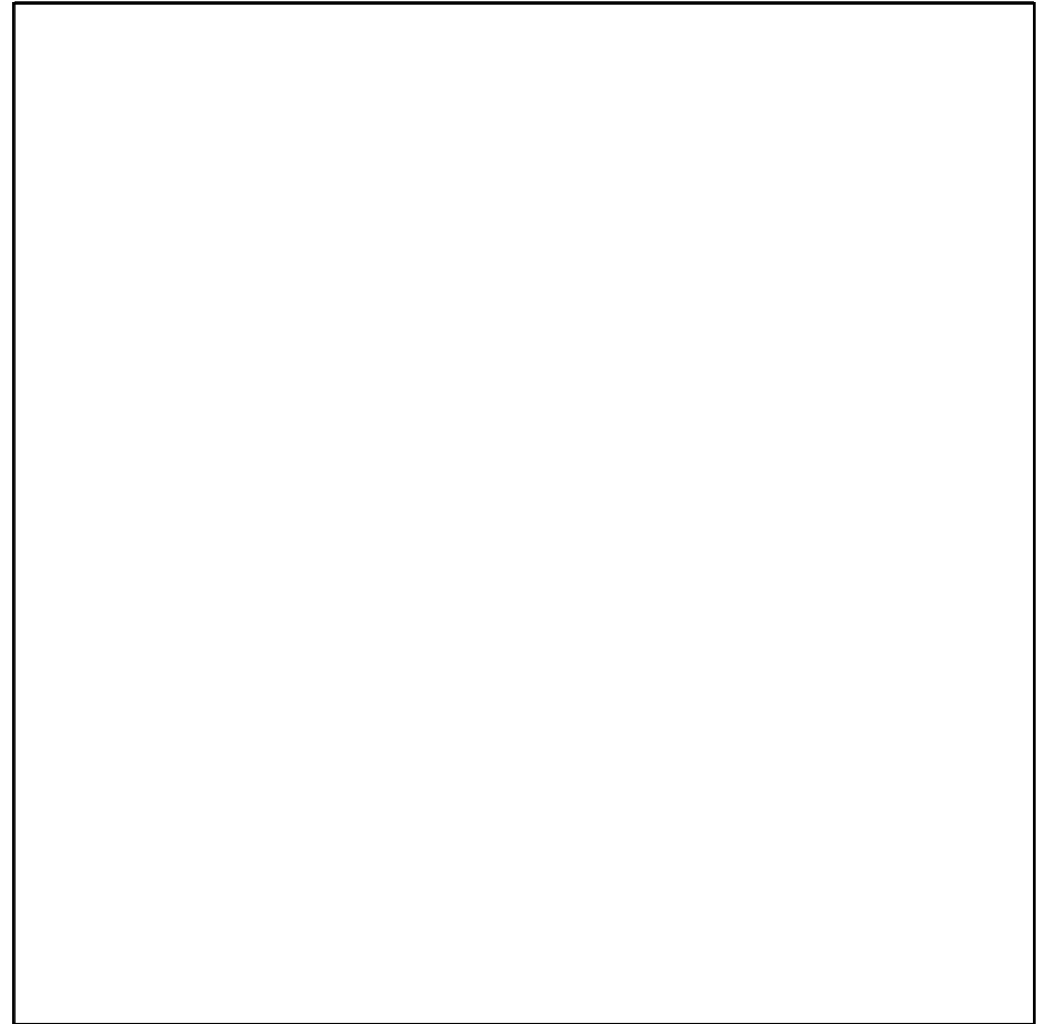
- \_ Foreground or background blurred or made fuzzy
- \_ Changes in depth of field
- \_ Emphasis achieved by keeping main element in focus



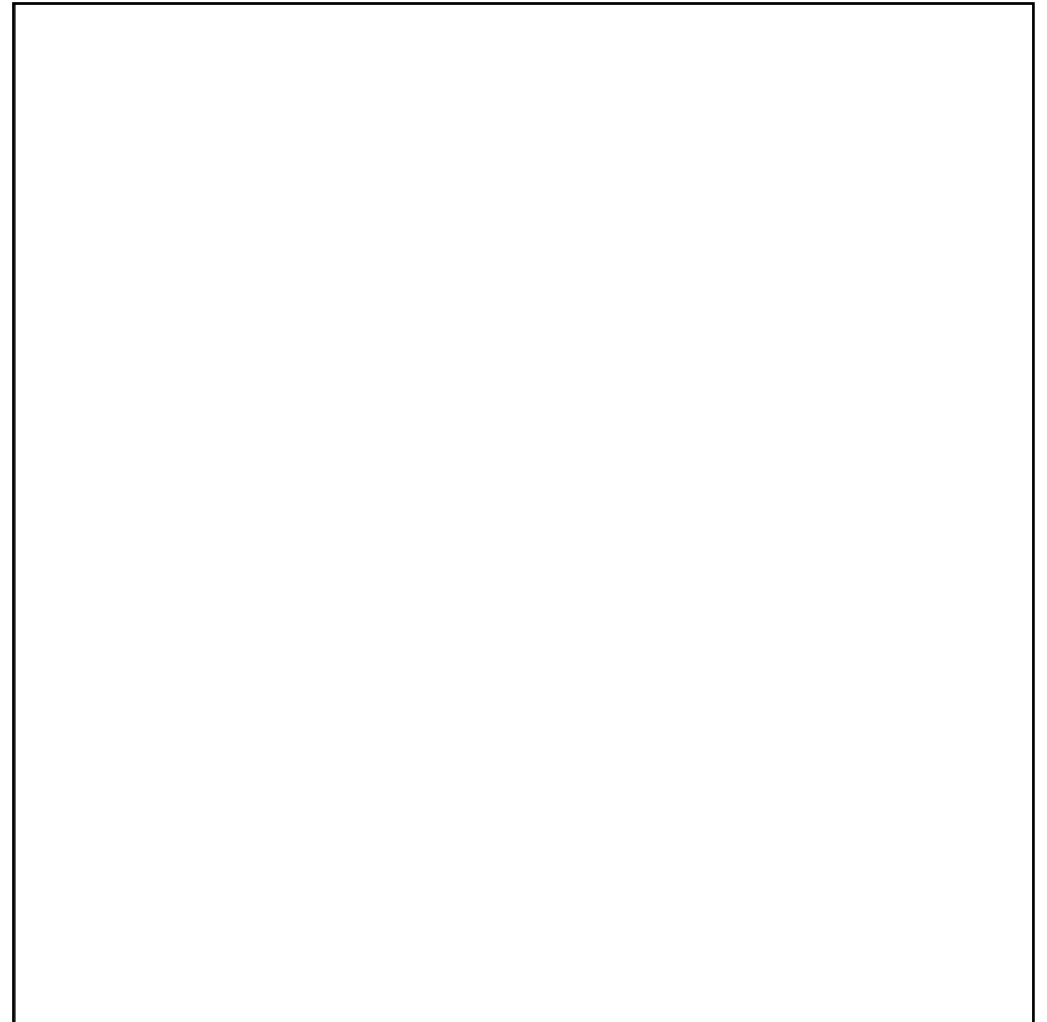
# \_ Accentuation through uppercasing
